If you pass away without a Will, pursuant to the *Succession Act 2006* (NSW), your estate will pass to the first applicable class of person/s in the following order.

1 **SPOUSE/S**



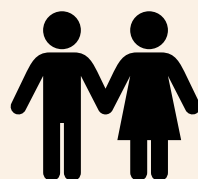
2 **SPOUSE/S AND CHILDREN OF ANOTHER SPOUSE**



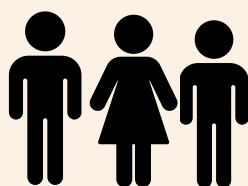
3 **CHILDREN\***



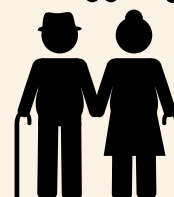
4 **PARENTS**



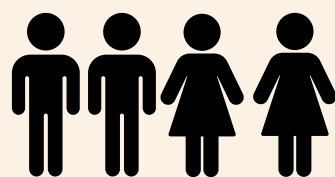
5 **SIBLINGS\*\***



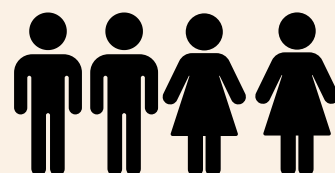
6 **GRANDPARENTS**
